## **Research:**

### **Brief summary of research over last five years**

Research over the last five years has concentrated on the following topics:

- The syntactic projection of function words in the non-clausal system; i.e. nominal, adjectival and prepositional constructions.
- Displacement phenomena, with an emphasis on so-called predicate displacement operations.
- The morpho-syntactic encoding of grammatical micro-variation in the Dutch nominal domain
- The syntax of semi-lexical and silent nouns
- Language and affect: the syntax of cursing; interjections; emphatic/affective, morphosyntactic markers.
- The syntax of Dutch. I am the coordinator of the research group Syntax of Dutch, which is part of the larger project *Taalportaal. The Linguistics of Dutch and Frisian Online* (see <http://www.taalportaal.org/>). Taalportaal will ultimately be an interactive knowledge base about of the grammars (phonology, morphology, syntax) of Dutch and Frisian.
